


Installing Good On Your Android Device


*****You will need to create a Google Play account if you do not already have one. This will be used to download software from Play Store.*****




1) Tap on the Play Store icon.




2) Tap on the Magnifying Glass Search icon at the top of the screen to open a store search box.




3) Type Good for Enterprise in the search field and tap the magnifying glass to search.




4) In the search results tap INSTALL.




5) Tap Accept for App permissions.



6) The app will begin to download.




7) Once the app downloads and installs you will have the option to OPEN, tap OPEN.




8) Tap Start on the "Welcome to Good for Enterprise" screen.




9) Tap Agree to the license agreement.



10) Enter your full email address and Good Messaging PIN as seen in your welcome email. Once you have entered the information, tap Next.



11) The app will begin to go through a few steps to authenticate use and retrieve settings amongst others. This may take several minutes.



12) Good will finish authenticating. Once complete, you will see the "Congratulations screen". Tap Done.



13) A screen will notify you that a password is required. Tap OK and set a password that meets the security requirements displayed.



14) Email should begin to synchronize and within 30 minutes, all of your contacts, calendar entries, tasks, notes and emails will load to your device during that time.
