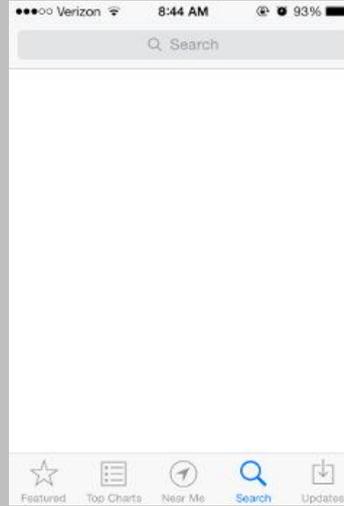


Installing Good On Your iOS Device

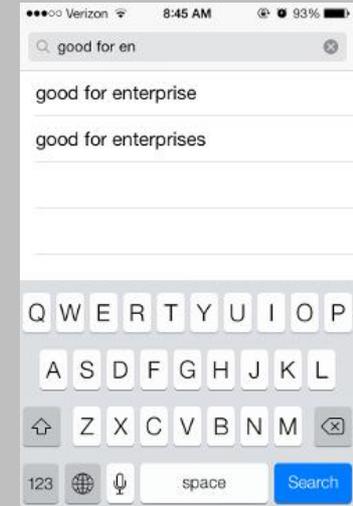
*****You will need to create an iTunes account if you do not already have one. This will be used to download software from the iTunes Store.*****



1) Tap on the App Store icon on your iPhone or iPad



2) Tap on the Magnifying Glass Search icon at the bottom of the screen to open a search dialog box.



3) Type in Good for Enterprise and hit search.



4) Next to Good for Enterprise, tap Free then tap Install.



5) You may be prompted for your AppleID password. Input your AppleID and password, then press OK. The file will begin to download and install.



6) Once the download is complete tap Open.



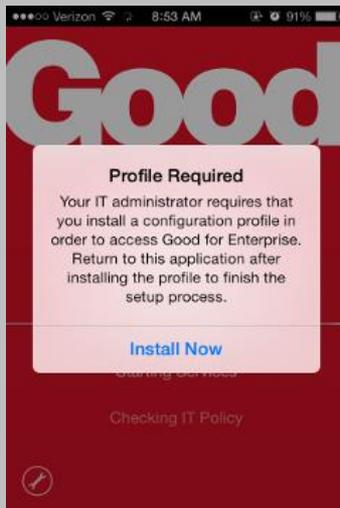
7) Tap Start on the Welcome to Good for Enterprise Setup screen.



8) Tap Accept on the "Good End User License Agreement" screen.



9) Enter your full email address and Good Messaging PIN as seen in your welcome email. Once you have entered the information, tap Next.



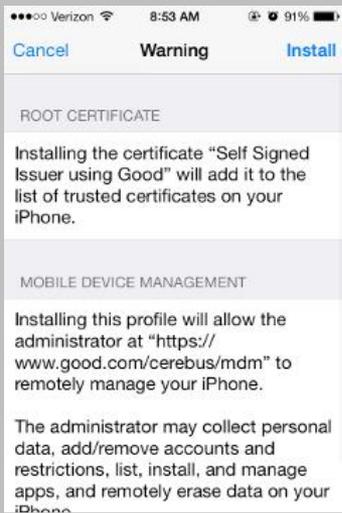
10) You will be prompted for a required profile installation. Tap Install Now.



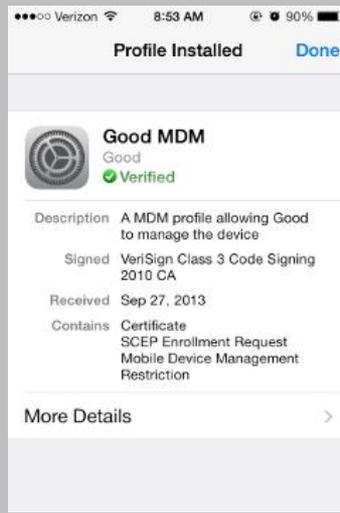
11) The profile will be displayed. Tap Install.



12) Verify profile installation by tapping Install Now.



13) A warning will come up for a Root Certificate. Tap Install.



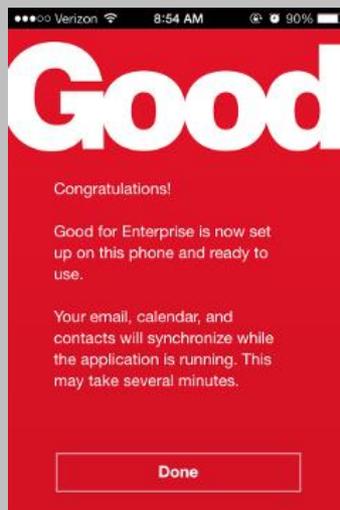
14) Profile will now install. Once complete, tap Done.



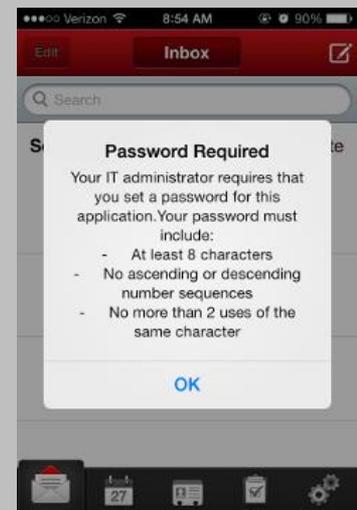
15) You will be directed to the Safari Browser. Press the Home button to return to the Home Screen.



16) Tap on the Good icon to open



17) Good will finish authenticating. Once complete, you will see the "Congratulations screen". Tap Done.



18) A screen will notify you that a password is required. Tap OK and set a password that meets the security requirements displayed.



19) Email should begin to synchronize and within 30 minutes, all of your contacts, calendar entries, tasks, notes and emails will have loaded to your device.
